In 2014 and 2015, he attended numerous Teaching Seminars and the PGA Expo in Las Vegas to better understand different teaching philosophies from top instructors in the Southwest PGA Section. In 2015, he obtained his Level One Certification from the Titleist Performance Institute (TPI), where he learned how to conduct a physical screening to determine if a golfer has any physical limitations that will cause certain swing flaws.



Jeff joined the Camelback golf staff in December of 2015 where he continues to have success on the lesson tee with both male and female golfers of all ages and experience levels. He utilizes golf industry technologies including K-Vest human motion learning, Hudl Technique Elite Video Analysis, FlightScope launch monitor, and 3-Bays putting swing analyzer to help his students expedite their learning process. In 2016, he continued to gain certifications through TPI's junior level 2 coaching, Power level 2 coaching, and K-Vest human motion learning system to expand his skills to become a preferred junior golf coach in the Scottsdale area. In the fall of 2016, he became the middle school and high school head golf coach at Veritas Prep Academy in Phoenix, Arizona. Jeff is dedicated to researching different teaching philosophies to become a more effective golf instructor and enjoys giving people the skill to play the game of golf for the rest of their lives.
