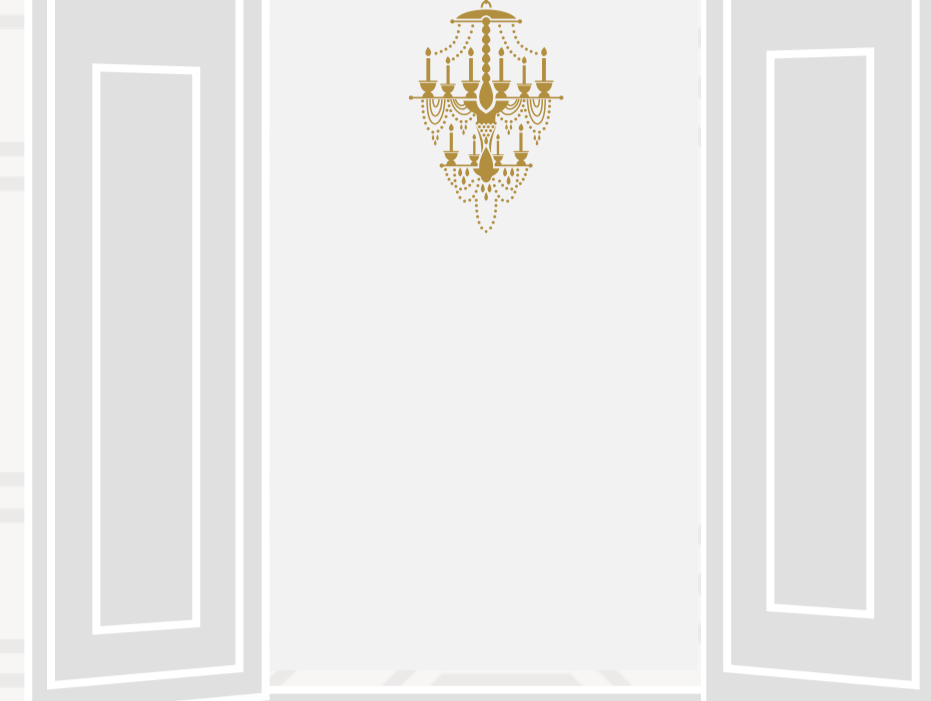


“Where Meetings Make History”

1925

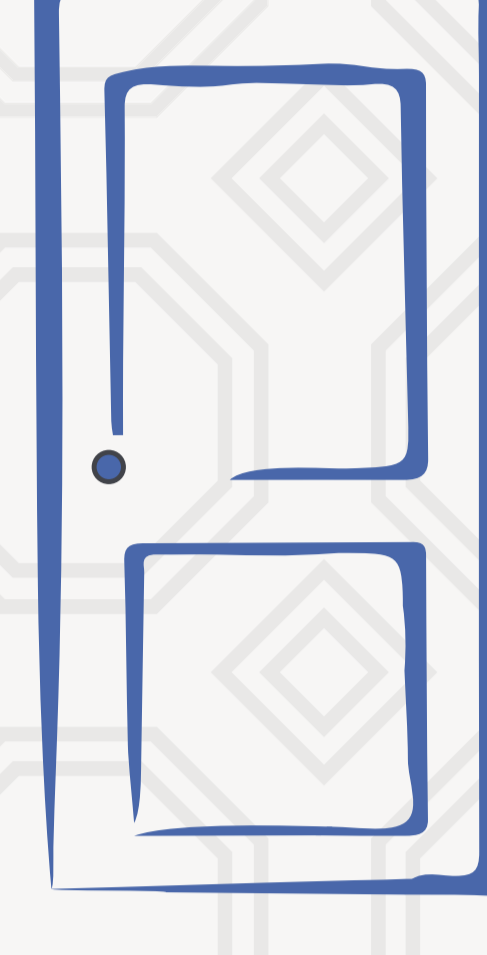
The hotel opens its doors and hosts President Calvin Coolidge’s Inaugural Ball just two weeks after its opening.

The acoustics in the Chinese Ballroom played a trick on Winston Churchill. While sipping his favorite tea, Churchill leaned over to his neighbor to tell an off-color joke. “Washington’s Second Best Address.”



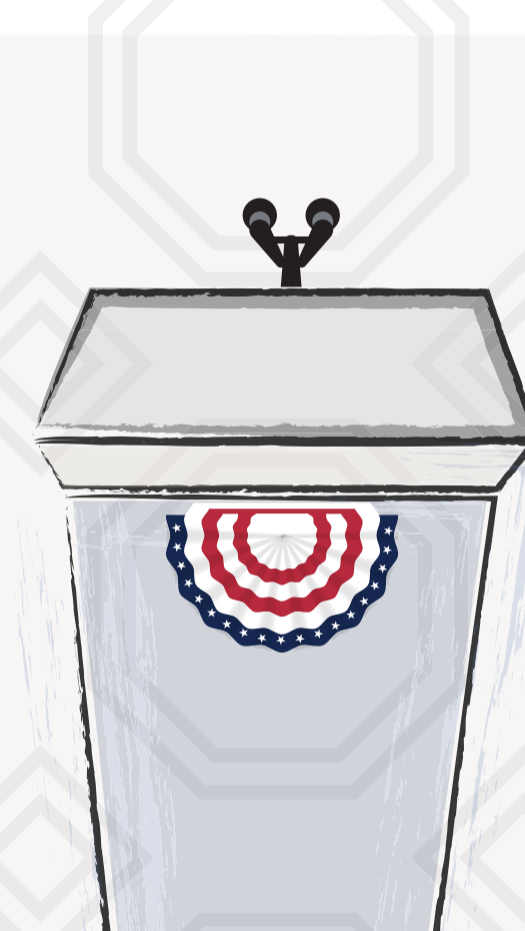
1981
