### SHOP ON SPRING GARDEN ROAD • 5670 Spring Garden Road, Halifax, NS, B3J 1H6

With more than 200 diverse retail shops, the Spring Garden Road area offers a world of goods, from fashion to home décor to jewelry and gifts. Stroll on foot to take in the charming shops and attractions.

### CANADIAN MUSEUM OF IMMIGRATION AT PIER 21 • 1055 Marginal Road, Halifax, NS, B3H 4P7

Visit the Canadian Museum of Immigration at Pier 21 and follow in the footsteps of the 1.5 million immigrants and Canadian military personnel who passed through Pier 21 between 1928 and 1971. Explore stories of immigration and nation-building through interactive exhibits, multimedia presentations and activities for all ages.

### NOVA SCOTIAN CRYSTAL • 5080 George Street, Halifax, NS, B3J 1M4

Canada's only maker of fine, mouth-blown, hand-cut crystal is located on the waterfront. It is well worth a trip to the glassworks studio to watch master craftsmen work their magic, turning molten sand into crystal. Visit the showroom and see the complete collection of these works of art. What started a generation ago, from a group of Irish immigrants with a commitment to preserving an ancient craft that is disappearing in the world, has become a truly Canadian story of respect for tradition, beauty and fine craftsmanship.

### ART GALLERY OF NOVA SCOTIA

Nova Scotia's largest art gallery displays a wide range of local, national and touring exhibitions, from traditional folk art to innovative contemporary works. The Gallery strives to bring the finest travelling exhibitions to Atlantic Canada from around the world.

### ALEXANDER KEITH'S NOVA SCOTIA BREWERY • 1475 Hollis Street, Halifax, NS, B3J 3M4

Visit Canada's oldest working brewery (dating back to 1820). A historic downtown landmark, the massive granite building offers sights, smells and tastes to delight beer lovers and history buffs. Costumed interpreters guide visitors back in time through song and story. In true Nova Scotian style, the tour ends with a complimentary beer.
